Description of Trainings

"An Insight Into Autism Spectrum Disorders"

This workshop will discuss both the strengths and challenges that are often experienced by individuals on the autism spectrum. Areas covered include: diagnostic criteria, receptive and expressive communications skills, social competencies, sensory challenges, and the implementation of positive behavioral supports. Attendees will learn practical strategies used to facilitate the growth and development of students. There will be time for questions and answers.

"Asperger's 101"

This workshop will cover the areas addressed in "An Insight Into Autism" with a specific focus on Asperger's Syndrome.

"The Hidden Curriculum"

A workshop designed to introduce you to the importance of the "hidden curriculum" – the unwritten social rules and expectations of behavior that we all know but were never taught – and how a lack of these skills impacts individuals with an autism spectrum disorder (ASD).

Individuals who have ASD do not come equipped with the same ability to understand the hidden curriculum. As a result, they break many social and behavioral rules without intent or even knowledge that they are doing so. This, coupled with their difficulty in generalizing information from one situation to another, leads them to making the same mistakes over and over again at a tremendous social cost.

This workshop includes strategies and techniques to help children and adults understand social cues and unstated expectations, guidelines for what to do (or what not to do) in specific social situations, and practical tips.

Speaker Bio

Jason Litto has 14 years of experience working with individuals on the autism spectrum. He is certified as a special education teacher, and has experience teaching and consulting for both public and private schools. Jason has worked for Community Resources for People with Autism as an Autism Specialist and Family Support Manager offering a variety of supports to families of children with autism.
